When in Rome, do as the Romans and head to Trevi at the Forum Shops at Caesars Palace for one of the 12 flavors of gelato that pastry chef Hank Sbraccia makes at 2 a.m. each morning. The Italian eatery sitting outside the Fountain of the Gods goes through 250 to 350 pounds of gelato, a denser and richer version of ice cream with less air, every day. Sbraccia has made more than 350 flavors of gelati throughout the years, including experimental flavors such as prickly pear cactus and tomato basil. Kids will love the spaghetti ice with strands of white gelato as the spaghetti, strawberry sauce as marinara and shaved white chocolate for parmesan cheese.
